

ORDINANCE 62507-2

An Ordinance To Establish Hours and Days
In Which Consumer Fireworks may be used, Ignited, or Discharged.

WHEREAS, the Indiana Legislature has passed P.L. 177-2007 (S.E.A. 9) which has amended I.C. 22-11-14-10.5, and

WHEREAS, such legislation has empowered local municipalities to set dates and hours of when the public can use, ignite or discharge fireworks, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of DeMotte is desirous of exercising the options given it under Senate Enrolled Act 9 of the 2007 Session of the Indiana Legislature.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEMOTTE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The use of consumer fireworks within the corporate limits of the Town of DeMotte shall be limited to the following times and dates:
 - A. Between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and two (2) hours after sunset on June 29, June 30, July 1, July 2, July 3, July 5, July 6, July 7, July 8, and July 9;
 - B. Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on July 4; and
 - C. Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. on December 31 and 1:00 a.m. on January 1.
2. That violation of the times and dates as provided in this ordinance shall be an ordinance violation, subject to a fine of up to \$250.00
